

Food Supplement (LNS-MQ) Distribution

In times of crisis, the provision of food and nutritional Food Supplements becomes a necessity and presents challenges. Recognizing the needs of the most vulnerable individuals, the World Food Programme (WFP) is keen to provide supplementary food for breast-feeding and pregnant mothers, as well as children under 5 years. The primary goal is to complement the nutritional needs of pregnant and breastfeeding mothers (PBW) and children. Sharek Youth Forum is collaborating with the WFP on the distribution of these supplements to reach the most vulnerable groups in the Gaza Strip by distributing these items and raising social behaviour change sensitization on infant and child feeding practices during emergency.



Consequently, our team has been unwavering in its commitment to providing essential support. The recent completion of the first distribution cycle marks a significant milestone in our ongoing efforts reaching a total of 45,467 of PBW and children.

This intervention had been carried out after equipping a team of 20 volunteers with the necessary knowledge to ensure the seamless implementation of the distribution. Our dedicated team underwent specialized training conducted by the WFP experts.







Our teams worked on distributing the LNS-MQ units in the UNRWA shelters in Rafah. However, the eyes of our volunteers is set onto reaching other localities and extend the benefit to all reachable groups in the Gaza Strip with the constant support of the WFP teams.
